ABOUT ICHPE CONFERENCES

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The International Conference on Health Professions Education (ICHPE) is one of the premier conferences in the field of Medical Education, hosted in Pakistan by The University of Lahore (UOL). In August 2014, the first ICHPE conference was held in Lahore, the theme of the conference was "Health Professions Education: The Change Imperative".

The second ICHPE conference was held after a hiatus of four years, under the theme "Emerging Trends in 21st Century" and was heralded as one of the best Medical Education conferences of that year in Pakistan. The following year the third ICHPE conference was hosted by UOL. Theme of the conference was: Student Centered Education: Missing Piece in the Preceptor's Belief" and for the second year in a row the conference garnered unbounded praise and appreciation, not just in Pakistan but also from the international participants.

At UOL, the health and safety concerns of our conference attendees and delegates are of paramount importance to us. Complying with requisite distancing of the current pandemic, we decided to host the 4th ICHPE as a virtual conference, on the 21st & 22nd of October, 2020. The theme of the conference was "Training Tomorrow's Doctor: Team Up!".

The 5th ICHPE will be held as a virtual conference this year, from 29th Oct- 3rd November-2021. The theme of the conference is **"TECHMED: Changing the landscape of Medical Education through Technology Enhanced Learning"**.

PLENARY SPEAKERS

Title: Every Teacher can Demonstrate Scholarship in Education



Speaker: Prof. Ronald Harden

Prof. Ronald Harden is Professor of Medical Education, University of Dundee, General Secretary and Treasurer of the Association for Medical Education in Europe (AMEE) and Editor of the renowned journal "Medical Teacher". As one of the most celebrated Professors of Medical Education he served as Dean and Director of the Centre for Medical Education at the University of Dundee, and Director of the Educational Development Unit of the Scottish Council for Postgraduate Medical and Dental Education. He brings to medical education a unique blend of theory and practical experience. He has written extensively in his areas of interest and has published papers in leading journals

Title: Enhancing dignity in the workplace using the "Body Swap" virtual reality application



Speaker: Prof. Lynn Monrouxe

With a background in psychology and cognitive linguistics, she has developed an international reputation for high-quality research in the field of healthcare professions' education and presently has over 100 peer-reviewed articles in high-ranking medical education and social sciences journals and books. She has examined a range of teaching, learning and professionalism-related issues around undergraduate and postgraduate work-based learning. She has pioneered the solicited audio diary method in medical education research and publishes theory-method advancements. She has led on the most comprehensive video-ethnographic study of bedside teaching to date. She co-leads a program of research (12-years to date) on healthcare professionalism resulting in a co-authored textbook for the healthcare professions (Monrouxe LV & Rees CE 2017).

Prof. Hossam Hamdy is a Professor of Surgery and Medical Education. An internationally known medical educator and active Pediatric Surgeon. A scholar, professional, and leader in higher education in the Middle East and renowned internationally for the last 40 years, he has established several Medical Colleges in Egypt, Bahrain, and UAE. He has served in different senior academic and administrative positions as Chancellor, Gulf Medical University, Vice-Chancellor Medical & Health Science Colleges, Sharjah University, Director of the Institute of Leadership in Higher Education, Sharjah University and Dean College of Medicine, Arabian Gulf University, Bahrain. Prof. Hamdy is a WHO Consultant in Medical Education and a member of the Editorial Board of several Journals in Medical Education. He is active in research and has published more than 70 studies that are highly cited and introduce several innovation and best practices in Medical Education. His work and contribution to Medicine and Medical Education over more than 40 years has been acknowledged and has won him many awards: The Sheikh Khalifa Award for Higher Education for "Distinguished Professor in Teaching", led the College of Medicine, Arabian Gulf University to win the "Sheikh Hamdan Bin Rashid Al Maktoum Award" for Best Medical College in the Arab world, "Fellow of the Royal College of Surgeons of England "By-Election" 2010", and "Fellow of the Royal College of Physician of England 2016".

Prof. Hossam Hamdy was decorated in 2011 by the Republic of France with the prestigious decoration as "Chevalier Dans L'ordre Des Palmes Academiques" / "Knight of the Order of Academic Palms" for his achievements in Medical Education.

He is the Chair Faculty Teaching Excellence Committee (FTEC) for Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine and Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health. In addition, Dujeepa leads the School of Medicine Continuous Quality Improvement team at the deanery and is the co-chair for faculty development in the residency program. He is also a member of the Undergraduate Curriculum Committee and Graduate Medical Education Committee, Faculty Assessment Committee, and the Curriculum Steering Committee at the School of Medicine and NUHS. At the MoH level, Dr. Dujeepa provides expertise in Undergraduate Medical Schools and Postgraduate specialty training accreditation. At the regional and international level Dr. Dujeepa is a member of the ASPIRE for Excellence panel and the association for Medical Education.

He also holds the positions of WHO Consultant in Medical Education, Adolescent Health & Primary Care, Educational Consultant for International Affairs RCGP Scotland, and Educational Consultant to WONCA and the World Federation of Medical Education (WFME). He is also a Professor of Medical Education, First Affiliated Hospital, Sun Yat-sen University, Guangzhou, China.

As an Oncologist, General Practitioner, and Academician for forty-five years, he has extensive experience in the development and delivery of Hospital-based, Primary Care, and Community-based Education. He has been involved with many of the innovations in curriculum transformation and Primary Care over these years, both in the UK and several different countries overseas.

His experience in General Practice and his interest in Medical Education have given him the opportunity to develop curricula in many parts of the world, specifically in those regions in which medical and healthcare education is often a challenge.

He writes extensively on the subject of Medical Education, with a special interest in the Social Accountability of Medical Schools and innovative models of healthcare education. As Associate Editor of Medical Teacher he held the specific responsibility for the development of the AMEE and BEME Guides in medical education, the Medical Education around the World series, as well as general publication duties. Simulation based medical education: The new normal?

Title: Let's aspire to "Simulation Based Interprofessional Education as the New Normal" Speaker: Prof. Dr. Charles Docherty



Prof. Charles Docherty studied nursing at Glasgow Royal Infirmary. While being a charge nurse in ICU, he obtained both Masters of Nursing and PhD from Glasgow University. His doctoral studies focused on the use of multimedia as a means of helping mentors assess students' clinical skills. Since 1988, Professor Docherty has been an educator and his research interests have paralleled innovative developments in education. In Glasgow Caledonian University he designed a simulation laboratory around a workflow based on an innovative educational paradigm. Working with the British Council in Jordan, he introduced a problem-based learning curriculum to Hashemite University, the first of its kind in the country. In 2008 he was appointed as Director of Clinical Simulation, Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland, Bahrain campus. During his time there he established a training centre for advanced clinical simulators, made dramatic improvements in business development within the school, transforming the curriculum and teaching methods. He was awarded an honorary Fellowship by the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland (RCSI) in 2011.

Title: Why Augmented Reality is Difficult to Implement in Medical Education

Prof. Dr. Rehan Ahmed Khan is Assistant Dean Medical Education and Professor of Surgery at Islamic International Medical College, Riphah International University and visiting Professor of Medical Education in University of Lahore. Main areas of his interest are Curriculum, Assessment and E-learning. He has developed an assessment instrument 'SLICE' for the assessment of Long case. He has been a leading team member in designing, developing and implementing integrated modular outcome-based curriculum at Islamic International Medical College. He is currently working on developing a tool on 'Curriculum Viability'. He has several publications and presented at numerous International Conferences.

Title: Simulation in Competency-based Medical Education: Still a missed opportunity

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
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
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
